A bill for an act

relating to criminal justice; limiting the applicability of the resisting arrest crime; amending Minnesota Statutes 2014, section 609.50, by adding a subdivision.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2014, section 609.50, is amended by adding a subdivision to read:

Subd. 3. **Applicability.** A person may not be arrested for a violation of subdivision 1, clause (2), that involves the person resisting the person's own arrest, if the person is not also arrested for another offense.

**EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective August 1, 2015, and applies to crimes committed on or after that date.
