Subd. 9. Awards. An undergraduate student who meets the office's requirements 1.7 is eligible to apply for and receive a grant in any year of undergraduate study unless the 1.8 student has obtained a baccalaureate degree or previously has been enrolled full time 19 or the equivalent for eight semesters or the equivalent, excluding courses taken from a 1.10 Minnesota school or postsecondary institution which is not participating in the state grant 1.11 program and from which a student transferred no credit. A student who withdraws from 1.12 enrollment for active military service, or for a major illness, while under the care of a 1.13 medical professional, that substantially limits the student's ability to complete the term is 1.14 entitled to an additional semester or the equivalent of grant eligibility. A student enrolled 1.15 in a two-year program at a four-year institution is only eligible for the tuition and fee 1 16 maximums established by law for two-year institutions. 1.17
