- 1.6 (a) April 2 of each year is designated Autism Awareness and Acceptance Day to
- 1.7 commemorate and celebrate the unique talents and innovations of those individuals with
- 1.8 autism in Minnesota while raising awareness about individuals with autism throughout the
- 1.9 state.
- 1.10 (b) Each year the governor shall issue a proclamation honoring the observance and
- 1.11 encouraging citizens to take the opportunity to learn about autism and to remember and
- 1.12 recognize the value and contributions of individuals with autism in the state.
