- 1.1 A bill for an act
- 1.2 relating to natural resources; allowing all-terrain vehicles in certain state
- 1.3 campgrounds; proposing coding for new law in Minnesota Statutes, chapter 84.
- 1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
- 1.5 Section 1. **[84.9258] CAMPGROUNDS ACCESSIBLE TO ALL-TERRAIN**
- 1.6 **VEHICLES; PILOT PROJECT.**
- 1.7 (a) A person may operate an all-terrain vehicle in campground areas designated by the
- 1.8 commissioner of natural resources under this section.
- 1.9 (b) By August 1, 2019, the commissioner of natural resources must designate the
- 1.10 following areas as accessible to all-terrain vehicles:
- 1.11 (1) a campground south of state Trunk Highway 169 at Lake Vermilion-Soudan
- 1.12 Underground Mine State Park;
- 1.13 (2) campgrounds at Hayes Lake State Park; and
- 1.14 (3) access routes to the campgrounds identified under this paragraph from nearby
- 1.15 all-terrain vehicle trails.
- 1.16 (c) Designations made under this section are not subject to the rulemaking provisions
- 1.17 of chapter 14, and section 14.386 does not apply.
- 1.18 (d) This section expires January 1, 2025.
- 1.19 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
