Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2016, section 297A.70, is amended by adding a subdivision
to read:
Subd. 20. Ice arenas and rinks. Sales to organizations that exist primarily for the purpose
of operating ice arenas or rinks used for youth and high school programs are exempt if the
organization is a private, nonprofit corporation exempt from federal income taxation under
section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.
EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective for sales and purchases made after June
30, 2017.
