1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to human services; appropriating money to develop a replicable homeless
1.3 youth drop-in program model.

1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. APPROPRIATION.

1.6 \$100,000 in fiscal year 2020 is appropriated from the general fund to the commissioner
1.7 of human services for a grant to an organization in Anoka County providing services and
1.8 programming through a drop-in program to meet the basic needs, including mental health
1.9 needs, of homeless youth in the north metropolitan suburbs, to develop a model of its
1.10 homeless youth drop-in program that can be shared and replicated in other communities
1.11 throughout Minnesota. This is a onetime appropriation.
