1.3 Statutes 2020, section 45.33, subdivision 1.

1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2020, section 45.33, subdivision 1, is amended to read:

1.6 Subdivision 1. **Prohibitions.** In ~~connection with~~ a classroom of an approved course,  
1.7 coordinators and instructors must not:

1.8 (1) recommend or promote the services or practices of a particular business;

1.9 (2) encourage or recruit individuals to engage the services of, or become associated with,  
1.10 a particular business;

1.11 ~~(3) use materials, clothing, or other evidences of affiliation with a particular entity;~~

1.12 ~~(4)~~ (3) require students to participate in other programs or services offered by the  
1.13 instructor, coordinator, or education provider;

1.14 ~~(5)~~ (4) attempt, either directly or indirectly, to discover questions or answers on an  
1.15 examination for a license;

1.16 ~~(6)~~ (5) disseminate to any other person specific questions, problems, or information  
1.17 known or believed to be included in licensing examinations;

1.18 ~~(7)~~ (6) misrepresent any information submitted to the commissioner;

1.19 ~~(8)~~ (7) fail to cover, or ensure coverage of, all points, issues, and concepts contained in  
1.20 the course outline approved by the commissioner during the approved instruction; and

2.1 ~~(9)~~ (8) issue inaccurate course completion certificates.
