1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. **[3.0985] COMPENSATION SUSPENDED AFTER ADJOURNMENT.**

1.7 Notwithstanding section 3.099 or other law to the contrary, members of the legislature

1.8 may not receive per diem living expenses after the governor calls a special session of the

1.9 legislature until all bills designated as major finance and revenue bills have been enacted.

1.10 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
