A bill for an act proposing an amendment to the Minnesota Constitution, article IX, section 1.2 1; requiring a two-thirds vote of each house of the legislature to submit a constitutional amendment to the people. 1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA: Section 1. CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT PROPOSED. 1.6 An amendment to the Minnesota Constitution is proposed to the people. If the amendment is adopted, article IX, section 1, will read: 1.8 Section 1. A majority Two-thirds of the members elected to each house of the legislature 19 may propose amendments to this constitution. Proposed amendments shall be published 1 10 with the laws passed at the same session and submitted to the people for their approval or 1.11 rejection at a general election. If a majority of all the electors voting at the election vote to 1.12 ratify an amendment, it becomes a part of this constitution. If two or more amendments 1.13 are submitted at the same time, voters shall vote for or against each separately. 1.14 Sec. 2.
