1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. **[16B.324] MANDATORY USE OF RENEWABLE ELECTRIC**
 1.7 **ENERGY IN STATE BUILDINGS.**

1.8 After January 1, 2020, all electric energy used in state-owned buildings located in
 1.9 the Capitol area as defined in section 15B.02 must be generated by an "eligible energy
 1.10 technology" as defined in section 216B.1691, subdivision 1, paragraph (a).
