1.2 relating to game and fish; modifying provisions for nonresident active duty military  
1.3 to obtain license to take fish; amending Minnesota Statutes 2020, section 97A.465,  
1.4 subdivisions 2, 3.

1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2020, section 97A.465, subdivision 2, is amended to read:

1.7 Subd. 2. ~~Camp Ripley personnel~~ **Nonresident active duty military**. A nonresident  
1.8 who is in ~~the military and in training at Camp Ripley~~ active service as a member of the  
1.9 United States armed forces, including the National Guard or other military reserves, may  
1.10 obtain a resident license to take fish.

1.11 Sec. 2. Minnesota Statutes 2020, section 97A.465, subdivision 3, is amended to read:

1.12 Subd. 3. **Nonresidents stationed in state**. The commissioner may issue a resident license  
1.13 to take fish or game to a ~~person~~ nonresident in the armed forces of the United States ~~that~~  
1.14 who is stationed in the state. This subdivision does not apply to ~~the~~ taking of moose or elk.
