1.1 A bill for an act  
 1.2 relating to consumer protection; prohibiting the possession, manufacture, or sale  
 1.3 of cellular telephone cases resembling a firearm; proposing coding for new law  
 1.4 in Minnesota Statutes, chapter 325F.

1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. **[325F.812] CELLULAR TELEPHONE CASES.**

1.7 No person shall purchase, possess, import, manufacture, sell, hold for sale, or  
 1.8 distribute a cellular telephone case, stand, or cover, that is a facsimile or appears to be a  
 1.9 firearm, including, but not limited to, a pistol or revolver.

1.10 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective August 1, 2016.
