1.1 A bill for an act  
1.2 relating to natural resources; requiring certain accessibility to publicly funded  
1.3 shooting ranges; proposing coding for new law in Minnesota Statutes, chapter  
1.4 87A.

1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. **[87A.09] PUBLIC SHOOTING RANGES; ACCESSIBILITY.**

1.7 A publicly owned or managed shooting range that is funded in whole or part with  
1.8 public funds must be available for use by participants in a firearms safety instruction  
1.9 course under section 97B.015. The shooting range must be available during hours  
1.10 reasonable for youth participants. The range operator may charge a fee to cover any costs  
1.11 directly incurred from use required under this section, but may not charge a fee to offset  
1.12 costs for general maintenance and operation of the facility.
