1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to liquor; modifying items for sale at exclusive liquor stores; amending
1.3 Minnesota Statutes 2018, section 340A.412, subdivision 14.

1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2018, section 340A.412, subdivision 14, is amended to
1.6 read:

1.7 Subd. 14. **Exclusive liquor stores.** (a) Except as otherwise provided in this subdivision,
1.8 an exclusive liquor store may sell only the following items:

1.9 (1) alcoholic beverages;

1.10 (2) tobacco products;

1.11 (3) ice;

1.12 (4) beverages, either liquid or powder, specifically designated for mixing with intoxicating
1.13 liquor;

1.14 (5) soft drinks;

1.15 (6) liqueur-filled candies;

1.16 (7) meat-based food products that contain 1/20 of one percent alcohol by volume;

1.17 ~~(7)~~ (8) other food products that contain more than one-half of one percent alcohol by
1.18 volume;

1.19 ~~(8)~~ (9) cork extraction devices;

1.20 ~~(9)~~ (10) books and videos on the use of alcoholic beverages;

- 2.1 ~~(10)~~ (11) magazines and other publications published primarily for information and
2.2 education on alcoholic beverages;
- 2.3 ~~(11)~~ (12) multiple-use bags designed to carry purchased items;
- 2.4 ~~(12)~~ (13) devices designed to ensure safe storage and monitoring of alcohol in the home,
2.5 to prevent access by underage drinkers;
- 2.6 ~~(13)~~ (14) home brewing equipment; and
- 2.7 ~~(14)~~ (15) clothing marked with the specific name, brand, or identifying logo of the
2.8 exclusive liquor store, and bearing no other name, brand, or identifying logo.
- 2.9 (b) An exclusive liquor store that has an on-sale, or combination on-sale and off-sale
2.10 license may sell food for on-premise consumption when authorized by the municipality
2.11 issuing the license.
- 2.12 (c) An exclusive liquor store may offer live or recorded entertainment.
