- 1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
- 1.6 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2018, section 16E.0466, subdivision 1, is amended to read:
- 1.7 Subdivision 1. **Consultation required.** (a) Every state agency with an information or
- 1.8 telecommunications project must consult with the Office of MN.IT Services to determine
- 1.9 the information technology cost of the project. Upon agreement between the commissioner
- 1.10 of a particular agency and the chief information officer, the agency must transfer the
- 1.11 information technology cost portion of the project to the Office of MN.IT Services. Service
- 1.12 level agreements must document all project-related transfers under this section. Those
- 1.13 agencies specified in section 16E.016, paragraph (d), are exempt from the requirements of
- 1.14 this section.
- 1.15 (b) Notwithstanding section 16A.28, subdivision 3, any unexpended operating balance
- 1.16 appropriated to a state agency may be transferred to the information and telecommunications
- 1.17 technology systems and services account for the information technology cost of a specific
- 1.18 project, subject to the review of the Legislative Advisory Commission, under section 16E.21,
- 1.19 subdivision 3.
- 1.20 (c) Notwithstanding paragraph (b), no amount under this section shall be transferred
- 1.21 from the health care access fund.
