Minnesota Statutes 2018, section 204B.16, is amended by adding a subdivision 1.6 to read: 1.7 Subd. 8. Polling places; public colleges and universities. (a) If a campus is located 1.8 within the boundaries of a municipality, the governing body of the municipality must 1.9 establish a precinct for the campus and designate a polling place in that precinct. If a campus 1.10 is located in more than one municipality, each municipality must designate a separate 1.11 precinct on the campus. Each polling place located on a campus must have ballots for every 1.12 precinct located on the campus and for each adjacent precinct to the campus. 1.13 (b) For purposes of this subdivision, "campus" means a public college or university 1.14 campus that is operated by the Minnesota State Colleges and Universities or the University 1.15 of Minnesota with a total enrollment of 5,000 or more students and with on-campus student 1.16 housing. 1.17
