1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. **[2.585] FIFTY-EIGHTH DISTRICT.**

1.7 Subdivision 1. **Senate district.** Senate District 58 consists of that district as described

1.8 in the order of the Minnesota Special Redistricting Panel in Wattson v. Simon, Nos.

1.9 A21-0243, A21-0546 (February 15, 2022).

1.10 Subd. 2. **House of representatives districts.** Notwithstanding the order of the Minnesota

1.11 Special Redistricting Panel in Wattson v. Simon, Nos. A21-0243, A21-0546 (February 15,

1.12 2022), Senate District 58 is divided into two house of representatives districts as follows:

1.13 (a) House of Representatives District 58A consists of the district as described in that

1.14 order, with the modification contained in file L58A-1, on file with the Geographic

1.15 Information Systems Office of the Legislative Coordinating Commission and published on

1.16 its website on March 29, 2022.

1.17 (b) House of Representatives District 58B consists of all territory of Senate District 58

1.18 not included in House of Representatives District 58A, as described in paragraph (a).

1.19 Sec. 2. **EFFECTIVE DATE.**

1.20 This act is effective for the state primary and state general elections conducted in 2022

1.21 for terms of office beginning on the first Monday in January of 2023, and for all elections

1.22 held thereafter.
