1.1 A bill for an act

1.2 relating to capital investment; appropriating money for a day shelter in the city of

1.3 St. Paul.

1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. **APPROPRIATION; LISTENING HOUSE.**

1.6 \$1,000,000 in fiscal year 2023 is appropriated from the general fund to the commissioner

1.7 of employment and economic development for a grant to Listening House of St. Paul, a

1.8 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization, to acquire real property, including a building and parking

1.9 lot on parcels located at 421, 423, and 423a East 7th Street in the city of St. Paul to serve

1.10 as a permanent day shelter. This appropriation is onetime and is available until the project

1.11 is completed or abandoned, subject to Minnesota Statutes, section 16A.642.

1.12 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
