**4515.0100 DEFINITIONS.**

**4515.0300 APPLICABILITY OF THE CONFLICTS OF INTEREST PROVISIONS.**

Any public official who, in the discharge of official duties, would be required to take action or make a decision which would substantially affect the official's financial interests, or those of a business with which he is associated, as that term is defined in Minnesota Statutes, section 10A.01, subdivision 4, must file a potential conflict of interest notice, unless the effect on the official is no greater than on other members of the official's business classification, profession, or occupation.
