CHAPTER 4600 DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH VITAL STATISTICS

4600 0900 FEES

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Subpart 1. Certified copy. Effective July 1, 1987, the fee for the issuance of either a certified copy of a birth, death, or marriage record or a certification that the record cannot be found shall be \$8. The fee for additional copies of the identical record requested at the same time shall be \$2 each. No fee shall be charged for a certified copy needed in connection with service in the armed forces or the Merchant Marine of the United States or in the presentation of claims to the United States Veterans Administration or the official veterans administration of any state or territory of the United States or for any copy needed by the commissioner of human services in connection with the needs of state wards. No fee shall be charged for verification of information requested by official agencies of this state, local governments in this state, or the federal government.

- Subp. 5. Fee for verification. The fee for the verification of information from or noncertified copies of a birth, death, or marriage record shall be \$8 when the applicant furnishes specific information to locate the record. When the applicant does not furnish specific information the fee shall be \$10 per hour for staff time expended. Specific information shall include the correct date of the event and the correct name of the registrant.
- Subp. 6. Copies of other documents. The fee for issuance of a certified or noncertified copy of any document on file pertaining to a vital record or a certification that a document cannot be found shall be \$5.
