4717.0200 DEFINITIONS.

Subp. 5a. Spa pool. "Spa pool" means a hot water pool intended for seated recreational use that includes a water agitation system in addition to the recirculation system. Spa pool is synonymous with the term "whirlpool."

Subp. 6. Special purpose pool. "Special purpose pool" means a treatment pool, therapeutic pool, special pool for water therapy, whirlpool, spa pool, or cold plunge.

4717.0310 FEES.

All plans for swimming pool construction, installation, or alteration submitted to the commissioner of health for review and approval under part 4717.0300 must be accompanied by the fee specified in this part:

A. each pool, except as provided in items B and C, \$500;

B. each spa pool, \$200; and

C. alterations to an existing pool without changing the size or configuration of the pool. \$200.
