4840.0500 APPROVAL OF NAMES AND DEGREES

4840.0500 APPROVAL OF NAMES AND DEGREES.

Subpart 1. **In general.** A school must be registered if it uses the term "academy," "institute," "college," or "university" in its name or if it grants a degree to a student in Minnesota, where the student has not left Minnesota for the major portion of the program or course leading to the degree. It also must substantially meet the criteria in subpart 2. In addition, it must meet the requirements in subparts 4 and 5, as applicable. The board shall maintain and publish a list of the schools approved to use regulated terms in their names and a list of schools approved to grant degrees with a list of the approved specified degrees.
