7884.0170 SCRATCHES.

Subp. 3. On advice of veterinarian. A horse scratched by the stewards on the advice of the commission veterinarian or the association veterinarian shall not be allowed to enter for a minimum of five days as determined by part 7877.0175, subpart 8, or until approved for entry by the commission veterinarian or the association veterinarian.

7884.0230 RACING EQUIPMENT.

Subp. 3. Helmets must be worn. All persons must wear a protective helmet approved by the Snell Foundation or the United States Department of Transportation with the chin strap properly fastened at all times when racing, jogging, training, or when warming up a horse on the grounds of an association.
