Subp. 3. Bleeders imported from other jurisdictions. A horse shipped into Minnesota from another jurisdiction shall be allowed to race on Lasix® provided it raced on Lasix® in its last start, and documentation to that effect is submitted to and accepted by the commission veterinarian at the Minnesota racetrack to which it is shipped; and that this transmission occurs prior to the initial entry of the horse into a race at the current race meeting.

- Subp. 5. **Restrictions on confirmed bleeders.** Confirmed bleeders shall be subject to the following restrictions:
- A. For the first observed bleeding in Minnesota, the horse shall be placed on the bleeder list and the veterinarian's list and shall not be removed from the veterinarian's list without the approval of the commission veterinarian. Such a horse shall be ineligible to race for at least 12 days following the observed bleeding.
- B. When a horse has been observed bleeding for the second time in Minnesota, the horse shall be placed on the veterinarian's list and shall not be removed from the list without the approval of the commission veterinarian. Such a horse shall be ineligible to race for at least 21 days following the observed bleeding.
