7891.0110 POSTMORTEM EXAMINATION.

Subpart 1 Horses that must undergo postmortem examination. Every horse which suffers a breakdown at a licensed racetrack under the jurisdiction of the commission, in training or m competition, and which is euthanized, and every horse which expires while stabled at a licensed racetrack under the jurisdiction of the commission, shall undergo a postmortem examination to be conducted by the commission veterinarian or the veterinarian's designee to determine the injury or illness which resulted in euthanasia or natural death A Class D license holder or the licensed trainer at a Class B license facility is responsible for furnishing transportation, within six hours of death, to deliver a horse to a postmortem site to be determined by the commission veterinarian
