"Inappropriate and harmful use" means use of a chemical which exceeds social or legal standards of acceptability, the outcome of which is characterized by three or more of the following: All Comments [For text=of items A to D, see MR!] E. loss of friends due to behavior while intoxicated; F. chemical use that prohibits one from meeting work, school, family, or social . . . 27 S. E. A. obligations; or G continued use of chemicals by a woman after she has been informed that she is pregnant and that continued use may harm her unborn child. "Pathological use" means the compulsive use of a chemical characterized by three or more of the following: [For text of items A to D, see M.R.] E. amnesic periods for events occurring while intoxicated; F. continuing use despite a serious physical disorder that the individual knows is exacerbated by continued use; or G. continued use of chemicals by a woman after she has been informed that she is pregnant and that continued use may harm her unborn child.
