

4626.0045 2-201.12 EXCLUSIONS AND RESTRICTIONS.*

The person in charge shall:

A. exclude a food employee from a food establishment if the food employee is ill with vomiting or diarrhea;

B. restrict a food employee from working with exposed food, clean equipment, and clean utensils in a food establishment if the food employee has an enteric bacterial pathogen capable of being transmitted by food, including *Salmonella* spp., *Shigella* spp., or *Escherichia coli* O157:H7, until the Department of Health and the licensing regulatory authority have evaluated the potential for foodborne disease transmission; and

C. restrict an employee if the results of an epidemiological investigation by the commissioner of health under Minnesota Statutes, section 31.171, determines that a food employee or applicant presents a risk for transmission of foodborne disease.
