4626.1125 WATER RESERVOIR OF FOGGING DEVICES; CLEANING. 5-205.14

- A. A reservoir that is used to supply water to a produce fogger or similar device must be:
 - (1) maintained according to the manufacturer's specifications;_{P1} and
- (2) cleaned according to the manufacturer's specifications or according to the procedures in item B, whichever is more stringent._{P1}
- B. Cleaning procedures must include at least the following steps and must be conducted at least once a week:
 - (1) draining and complete disassembly of the water and aerosol contact parts;_{P1}
- (2) brush-cleaning the reservoir, aerosol tubing, and discharge nozzles with a suitable detergent solution; $_{P1}$
- (3) flushing the complete system with water to remove the detergent solution and particulate accumulation; p_1 and
- (4) rinsing by immersing, spraying, or swabbing the reservoir, aerosol tubing, and discharge nozzles with an effective sanitizing chemical per the manufacturer's recommendations._{P1}
