9220.0420 REVOCATION OF PERMIT.

Subpart 1. **Justification for revocation.** The following constitute justification for the commissioner to begin proceedings to revoke a permit:

A. existence at the facility of unresolved noncompliance with the permit or applicable state and federal statutes and rules, and the permittee is unwilling or unable to resolve the noncompliance;

B. the operation of the facility has terminated; or

C. the commissioner finds that the facility endangers human health or the environment and that the danger cannot be removed by a modification of the permit.

Subp. 2. **Procedure for revocation.** The commissioner shall give notice of the commissioner's intent to revoke a permit by following the procedures in part 9220.0340. This notice must state that the permittee may request that a contested case hearing be held on the proposed action. If the agency grants a contested case hearing, the agency shall hold the hearing in accordance with the rules of the Office of Administrative Hearings, parts 1400.5100 to 1400.8500.
