ORDER ON REVIEW OF ADDITIONAL NOTICE PLAN

This matter came before Administrative Law Judge Kimberly Middendorf upon the request of the Minnesota Pollution Control Agency (MPCA) for a legal review under Minn. R. 1400.2060 (2021) of its Additional Notice Plan in the above-captioned proceeding.
