The state board of medical examiners has been given broad powers in respect to the licensing of medical practitioners, suspending such licenses or revoking them, for causes specified in the act. Within its granted powers the board exercises non-judicial functions; and since the act makes provision for notice and right to be heard, with right of review by appeal to the district court on questions of both law and fact so that any error may be corrected, injunctive relief will not be granted at the suit of one who has as his basis for such relief merely the fear that proceedings to discipline him may be brought. *Fisch v Sievertsen*, 208 M 102, 292 NW 758.
