313.01 FORMATION OF CORPORATION.

An orphanage is not entitled to send the children cared for by it to the public school of the district in which the home is situated without arrangements being made by the board of that district. It is for the board of the district to determine whether to receive the children and to fix tuition charges, in case it desires to charge. In this case the opinion is given that the children of Vasa orphanage have the legal right to attend the Burnside school without the necessity of paying tuition. 1934 OAG 327, April 17, 1933 (169p).
