RETIREMENT ALLOWANCES TO EMPLOYEES OF CITIES OF THE
FIRST CLASS**422.01 DEFINITIONS.**

422.02 RETIREMENT ALLOWANCES TO EMPLOYEES.

The electors of Minneapolis may not amend its charter so that it would conflict with any general legislation concerning pension systems for employees. OAG Aug. 22, 1934 (335d).

This act (Laws 1919, Chapter 522) has applied to Minneapolis from the beginning and the adoption of a home rule charter by the city did not affect it, and all amendments to the act apply to such city. OAG June 19, 1935 (335d).

A present conditional incumbent is entitled to make application and become an employee entitled to a service allowance without having paid into the retirement fund the full allowance required by the act. OAG June 19, 1935 (335d).

Conditional present incumbents who comply with the 1935 amendment are entitled, upon retirement, to a pension throughout period of their service, not to exceed 25 years, figured to time of retirement and not merely to age 72. OAG June 19, 1935 (335d).

An employee after compulsory retirement may be temporarily employed. OAG May 3, 1944 (59a-29).

422.06 RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE FOR NON-CONTRIBUTING EMPLOYEES.

An employee remaining disabled from May 1918, to May 1921, ceased to be an employee for that period though he was receiving workmen's compensation during that time, and he cannot claim a retirement allowance, having finally retired in December, 1921. State ex rel v City of Minneapolis, 174 M 594, 219 NW 924.

An employee of Minneapolis who applied for a pension at the age of 74, but who had contributed nothing to the retirement fund, is not entitled to a pension. OAG Nov. 28, 1933.
