165.06 FERRIES ON STREAMS BETWEEN COUNTIES.

Where a bridge, a part of a regular highway crossing the Mississippi river which divides two counties, was destroyed, it is within the powers of the county boards under L. 1943, c. 530, to construct and operate a ferry until a bridge may be constructed. 1944 OAG 176, May 10, 1943 (370-D).
