SCHOOLS FOR THE DEAF AND THE BLIND

248.02 SCHOOL FOR THE DEAF; WHO MAY BE ADMITTED; EXPENSES.

Attendance at the Minnesota Braille and Sight-Saving School does not affect the poor relief settlement of a family of which a blind person is a member. OAG March 13, 1947 (339-0-2).

248.07 DUTIES OF DIRECTOR OF SOCIAL WELFARE.

The director of social welfare is not authorized to spend any part of legislative appropriation in behalf of blind for medical examination, corrective surgery, therapeutic treatment to correct or modify a physical condition, hospitalization, or similar. OAG April 19, 1944 (9-A-10).

248.08 PAYMENTS BY DIRECTOR OF SOCIAL WELFARE.

Director of public institutions has no authority respecting a blind person not institutionalized. OAG Sept. 17, 1943 (88-A).
