CHAPTER 31

FOODS AND FROZEN FOODS

31.01 DEFINITIONS

In actions to recover damages for injuries to plaintiffs caused by eating impure food products allegedly purchased at defendant's bakery, the issue of defendant's ownership is properly for the jury. Shindelus v Sevcik, 211 M 432, 1 NW(2d) 397.

31.02 UNLAWFUL TO SELL CERTAIN FOODS.

Plaintiff's wife purchased three impure chocolate eclairs from defendant. Damages were recoverable. Cermak v Sevcik, 215 M 204, 9 NW(2d) 508.

31.03 FOOD, WHEN DEEMED ADULTERATED.

31.05 SEIZURE, SEARCH WARRANTS.

Municipality may by ordinance authorize seizure and summary destruction of milk not conforming to legal standard. Nelson v City of Mpls. 112 M 16, 127 NW 445.

31.12 LABELING.

The label "orange juice" does not include concentrated juice to which water is added. OAG April 19, 1945 (135-B-6-K).

31.18 KOSHER AND NONKOSHER NOT TO BE USED WRONGFULLY.

Kosher foods are subject to classification and the commissioner may promulgate rules and regulations relating to that classification. OAG Oct. 2, 1933 (135-B-5).

31.28 SANITARY FOOD LAW.

While a county attorney need not function as a detective or a police officer, certain sections such as secions 31.14, 97.29, 144.28, and 211.33 tend to broaden his duties as set out in section 388.05. 1942 OAG 189, Nov. 10, 1942 (121-B-7).
