

CHAPTER 39

STALLIONS AND JACKS

39.01 HORSES USED FOR BREEDING PURPOSES TO BE REGISTERED.

Where the stallion serves only for those who have a part ownership, there is no "public use," and no license is required. OAG May 21, 1927 (630-B).

39.02 STALLION REGISTRATION BOARD; MEETINGS; DUTIES.

No objection has been raised to the action of the board in classifying stallions as "purebred," "grade," "crossbred," "nonstandard bred," "mongrel or scrub." OAG March 19, 1943 (293-B-13).

39.03 HORSES USED FOR BREEDING PURPOSES TO BE REGISTERED.

The stallion registration board has no power to change the list enumerated in section 39.03. The board should adopt rules and regulations prescribing the procedure by which the board will accord recognition of registry associations, and for the withdrawal of such recognition and deletion of the name from the list. OAG June 14, 1946 (630-B).
