

CHAPTER 486

COURT REPORTERS

486.01 APPOINTMENT; SECRETARIAL DUTIES; BOND.

Court reporters must furnish bond for the salaries paid them, only such services as are prescribed by law. OAG Jan. 21, 1946 (129).

486.02 STENOGRAPHIC RECORD.

The provision of rule 27 of the district court which requires the party requesting the reporting (as distinguished from transcribing) of the argument, to pay the reporter therefor, is invalid. *Jovaag v O'Donnell*, 189 M 315, 249 NW 676.

Reporters' salary covers all duties prescribed by section 486.02 including stenographic records of testimony in proceedings of trials before the judge. OAG Jan. 21, 1946 (129).

486.05 SALARIES.
