

**CHAPTER 597**

**DEPOSITIONS**

**597.08 SIGNING AND CERTIFYING.**

The trial court did not err in denying defendant's motion to suppress the deposition of plaintiff's witness on the grounds (1) that it was not timely filed, and (2) that the witness did not sign each page of the deposition, there being no claim that the deposition was not accurate or that defendant was prejudiced thereby. *Wolfson v Kohn*, 210 M 12, 297 NW 109.

**597.12 DEPOSITION, HOW USED; OBJECTIONS.**

If the party at whose instance a deposition was taken fails to read it, it may be introduced by his adversary. *Porter v Grennan*, 219 M 14, 16 NW(2d) 906.

**597.13 INFORMALITIES AND DEFECTS; MOTION TO SUPPRESS.**

Section 597.13 seeks to void the exclusion of depositions on purely technical grounds. *Wolfson v Kohn*, 210 M 12, 297 NW 109.
