CHAPTER 625

PREVENTION OF CRIME

625.01 CONSERVATORS OF THE PEACE.

This section is designed to deprive a dangerous person of power to do future mischief or crime, and secure his good behavior. It is not restricted by section 8, article 6, of the constitution. If the person under examination declines to enter into a recognizance with sufficient sureties the magistrate may commit the person to jail. In the instant case the writ of habeas corpus was quashed and the relator remanded to the custody of the sheriff. *State ex rel v Sargent*, 74 M 242, 76 NW 1129.
