## CHAPTER 85

## DIVISION OF STATE PARKS

**85.03 STATE PARKS, WAYSIDES, RECREATION RESERVES, MONUMENT SITES, AND MONUMENTS.**

There is no express or implied power by which a public service corporation may condemn a perpetual easement for construction and maintenance of an electric power carrying line through Jay Cooke State Park. Minnesota Power Co. v State, 177 M 343, 225 NW 164.

Money being available it is entirely within the sound discretion and determined policy of the director of state parks whether or not to participate in beautifying Toqua Lakes State Park by raising the water level in Toqua Lake, said lake being partly within the corporate limits of the village of Graceville.
