

CHAPTER 94

UNITED STATES AND OTHER LANDS AND STATE FORESTS.

94.01 LANDS GRANTED BY UNITED STATES.

The entryman acquires only a right of possession as against all except the federal government; he acquires no equitable title or interest until he has complied with all statutory conditions required for obtaining a patent; and the vesting of the equitable estate in the entryman is simultaneous with the acquisition of an absolute right to a patent. In re S. R. A. Inc., 219 M 493, 18 NW(2d) 442.

94.09 CERTAIN OTHER LANDS; HOW SOLD; APPRAISAL.

Until sale of land acquired through foreclosure of old age assistance liens, the commissioner of conservation has charge and control, and may lease the same and has full responsibility of management. 1944 OAG 55, Aug. 26, 1943 (521-P-4).

Lands acquired under old age assistance lien foreclosure and sold under the provisions of section 94.09 but the proceeds are disposed of under section 256.27. 1944 OAG 317, Aug. 21, 1943 (521-P-4).

Sale of real estate where the state title is acquired by escheat is governed by the provisions of sections 94.09, 94.10 and 94.16. OAG March 28, 1946 (700-D-28).

94.16 FUNDS, HOW DISPOSED OF.

The proceeds of lands acquired by foreclosure of old age assistance liens under section 94.09 are disposed of under provisions of section 256.27. 1944 OAG 317, Aug. 21, 1943 (521-P-4).
