SCHOOLS; DEAF AND SIGHT-SAVING

128A.03 Advisory councils.

128A.03 ADVISORY COUNCILS.

Subdivision 1. The state board of education may appoint an advisory task force on the Minnesota School for the Deaf and an advisory task force on the Minnesota Braille and Sight-Saving School to advise the board on policies pertaining to the control, management, and administration of these schools.

Subd. 2. If created the members shall be representative of the various geographic regions of the state, shall include parents or guardians of visually disabled or hearing impaired children, shall include a staff representative of the applicable school, and shall include two representatives from groups representing the interests of visually disabled or hearing impaired individuals, as applicable. All members shall have knowledge, experience and interest in the problems of visually disabled or hearing impaired children.

Subd. 3. The task forces shall expire and the terms, compensation and removal of members shall be as provided in section 15.059.
