## CHAPTER 147

# PHYSICIANS AND SURGEONS, OSTEOPATHS

147.02 Examination; licensing. 147.20 Resident physicians.

### 147.02 EXAMINATION; LICENSING.

[For text of subds 1 and 2, see M.S.1982]

Subd. 4. Continuing education. The board shall adopt rules requiring continuing education for physicians, surgeons, and osteopaths licensed under this chapter who regularly practice in the area of workers' compensation. These rules shall include rules relating to continuing education designed to assure the coordination of treatment, rehabilitation, and other medical services provided to injured employees under chapter 176. Rules relative to education regarding treatment under chapter 176 shall be adopted jointly with the commissioner of labor and industry. These rules shall be consistent with section 214.12.

#### 147.20 RESIDENT PHYSICIANS.

No person shall act as a resident physician without first obtaining a temporary certificate for graduate training. Any violation of this section is a gross misdemeanor. The provisions of this section do not apply to a doctor of medicine or doctor of osteopathy duly licensed and registered in this state to practice medicine in all of its branches, nor to a doctor of medicine duly enrolled and regularly attending graduate programs of the University of Minnesota or of the Mayo Foundation.
