343.01 Purposes; powers; county organization.

343.01 PURPOSES; POWERS; COUNTY ORGANIZATION.

Subd. 3. The society must be governed by a board of directors consisting of seven persons appointed by the governor. The governor, the commissioner of education, and the attorney general, or their designees shall serve as ex officio, nonvoting members of the board. The membership terms, compensation, removal, and filling of vacancies of board members other than ex officio members shall be as provided in section 15.0575; provided that the terms of two initial members shall expire in each of 1979, 1980, and 1981, and the term of the seventh initial member shall expire in 1982. The members of the board shall annually elect a chairman and other officers as deemed necessary. Meetings must be called by the chairman or at least two other members. The governor shall appoint an executive director who shall serve in the unclassified civil service at the governor's pleasure for a term coterminous with that of the governor. The executive director may employ other staff who shall serve in the unclassified civil service. The commissioner of administration upon request of the executive director shall supply the board with necessary office space and administrative services, and the board shall reimburse the commissioner for the cost.
