35.251 Anaplasmosis testing. 35.255 Pseudorabies program; rules.

35.251 ANAPLASMOSIS TESTING.

All breeding cattle entering Minnesota shall have a health certificate evidencing a negative test for anaplasmosis conducted at a state or federal laboratory within 30 days of entry. Cattle not so certified shall be immediately quarantined and tested for anaplasmosis at the expense of the cattle owner. Cattle having a positive reaction to the anaplasmosis test shall remain quarantined until testing free of anaplasmosis or be slaughtered. An anaplasmosis test shall not be required of steers, cattle shipped directly to a slaughtering establishment, cattle sent to a quarantine feed lot, and other cattle excepted by rule of the board of animal health. The board is authorized to adopt rules to implement the provisions of this section.

35.255 PSEUDORABIES PROGRAM; RULES.

The board of animal health shall adopt rules to implement a program to control pseudorabies in swine, including pseudorabies testing of breeding swine and restricted movement of feeder pigs.
