485.07 RECORDS TO BE KEPT.

Every clerk shall procure and keep the following records at the expense of his county:

(1) a register of actions, in which he shall enter the title of each action, whether originally commenced in the clerk's court, or brought there by appeal or transcript of judgment from another court of the state or the United States, and a minute of each paper filed in the cause, and all proceedings in them;

(2) a judgment roll, for each judgment rendered;

(3) a docket, in which he enters alphabetically the name of each judgment debtor, the amount of the judgment, and the precise time of its entry;

(4) indexes, as described in section 485.08, and any other records as the court may direct.

485.16 RECORD ALL ACTIONS FILED.

The clerks of the district courts of the several counties shall keep a record of all actions and proceedings, civil and criminal, filed in the court, and shall furnish to the state appellate courts any information concerning the actions as is prescribed by rule of civil procedure.
