593.21 MISCONDUCT OF OFFICER IN CHARGE OF JURY.

Every officer to whose charge a jury is committed by a court, who negligently or willfully, and without leave of the court, permits them, or any one of them, to receive any communication from any person, to make any communication to any person, to obtain or receive any book, paper, or refreshment, or to leave the jury room, is guilty of a misdemeanor.

593.48 COMPENSATION OF JURORS AND TRAVEL REIMBURSEMENT.

A juror shall be reimbursed for his roundtrip travel between his residence and the place of holding court at a rate of 15 to 24 cents per mile and shall be compensated at a rate of \$15 for each day of required attendance at sessions of the court. The compensation and reimbursement shall be paid out of the county treasury upon receipt of authorization to pay from the jury commissioner. A monthly report of payments to jurors shall be sent to the jury commissioner within two weeks of the end of the month in the form required by the jury commissioner.
