184.28 EXAMINATION.

Subd. 2. The department shall hold such examinations at such times and places as it shall determine. An examination fee of \$20 shall be paid by each applicant in addition to the license fee, which examination fee shall be retained by the department whether or not the applicant passes the examination. The examination fee shall be forfeited if the applicant does not take the examination within six months of the application date. The examination fee of \$20 shall cover the costs of preparing and printing the examinations and the cost of giving each person taking the examination a copy of the latest rules. Rules shall be kept on the premises readily available to the counselor, manager, or agent.

184.29 FEES.

Before a license is granted to an applicant, the applicant shall pay the following fee:

- (a) An employment agent shall pay an annual license fee of \$250 for each license.
- (b) A search firm exempt under section 184.22, subdivision 2, shall pay an annual registration fee of \$250, accompanying the annual statement to the commissioner.
- (c) An applicant for a counselor's license shall pay a license fee of \$20 and a renewal fee of \$10.
- (d) An applicant for an employment agency manager's license shall pay a license fee of \$20 and a renewal fee of \$10.
